Humanitarian Service/Volunteer – Compassion/Public Service



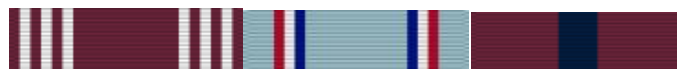
Distinguished Service – Dedicated to longevity of achieving personal and professional goals
